# **Opencast coal statistics 2013**

Comprehensive statistics on opencast coal have, in the past, been collected and published by the Planning Officers' Society. This series ceased in 1999. The Department for Communities and Local Government, the Welsh Government and the Scottish Government agreed that it would be valuable for a summary of opencast coal statistics to be continued. The BGS has been asked to undertake this collation in collaboration with the <a href="Coal Authority">Coal Authority</a> and Mineral Planning Authorities with opencast coal resources in their areas. In addition to dissemination on http://www.bgs.ac.uk/mineralsUK, the information will be summarised in the annual <a href="United Kingdom Minerals Yearbook">United Kingdom Minerals Yearbook</a>, also produced by BGS.

The survey has the support of the Planning Officers' Society, the Coal Authority and the Confederation of UK Coal Producers (CoalPro). The BGS would like to acknowledge the help of the Coal Authority and the relevant Mineral Planning Authorities in England, Scotland and Wales for their invaluable assistance in collecting the information for this survey. It will provide a vital input to monitoring Government policies for the development of the nation's shallow coal resources.

This survey was undertaken in 2014 and received a comprehensive return rate from the relevant Mineral Planning Authorities in England, Scotland and Wales. The following tables summarise the 2013 data:






